Faculty and students from the Chemistry Dept. participate in collaborative research w/ other departments across the university including Biology, Biochemistry, Physics, Molecular Physiology, Pharmacology, Microbiology, and Cell Biology. Below you will find info about two fellowship opportunities at the University.

- **Pratt Fellowship:** Awarded to several outstanding first-year students at the level of \$30,000 per year plus tuition and fees. Recipients of these fellowships have substantially reduced teaching responsibilities. Continued financial support at an enhanced level will be available to Pratt Fellows for two additional years on the basis of continued excellence in their academic and research programs.
- **Presidential Fellowship:** Awarded on a university-wide basis for a three-year period. Continued support is provided on the basis of continued satisfactory progress. Nominations for this fellowship are made by the department from the pool of applications completed by February 1. Persons holding NSF Predoctoral Fellowships (or other independent fellowships) will receive an appropriate supplement to bring their total stipend to \$30,000 per year or to enhance their graduate career in other ways, such as travel for research or to scientific meetings.
